WELCOME TO WCC MATURITY SEMINAR 101: APPROACHING MATURITY

We're glad you've chosen to find out more about World Conquerors Church and maturing your walk with God! This series of seminars will equip you with an understanding of what it means to be a member of the body of Christ and part of our church family to fulfill God's will for your life. We pray that through these seminars you may learn how we operate at World Conquerors Church and what you can do to mature in walking as a Christian and deepening your relationship with God the Father, the Son Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit (Colossians 4:12b).

Ephesians 4:14-15 instructs us that we are not to remain as children; rather we are to grow up in every way into Christ. WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A CHRISTIAN?

Most people live their entire lives without ever knowing “WHY?” They exist year after year with no idea of why they live or God’s purpose for their lives. The most basic question a person can ask is, “*What is the meaning of life?*”

Everyone wants to be happy. People try many ways:

- ...Some look for happiness by **acquiring possessions.**
- ...Some look for happiness by **experiencing pleasure.**
- ...Some look for happiness by **gaining prestige & power.**

II. WHAT'S THE PROBLEM?

Man has a natural desire to _____ and to ignore God's principles for living.

*"Look out for #1. Do your own thing."
"If it feels good, do it - regardless of what God says about it."
"It's my life and I'll do what I please!"*

THE BIBLE CALLS THIS ATTITUDE: _____.

"All of us, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way." Isaiah 53:6 (NIV)

"If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." 1 John 1:8 (NKJV)

Sin breaks our close relationship with God. It causes us to fear God and try to live our lives outside of His will.

"The trouble is that your sins have cut you off from God." Isaiah 59:2 (LB)

"For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard." Romans 3:23 (NLT)

When our relationship to God is not right, it causes PROBLEMS in every area of our lives — marriage, career, relationships, finances, etc.

WHEN PEOPLE HAVE PROBLEMS, THEY OFTEN TRY MANY DIFFERENT WAYS OF COPING BEFORE TURNING TO GOD.

“There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death.” Proverbs 16:25 (NIV)

Even when we know that our deepest need is God, we often try wrong ways of getting to know Him:

- “My mother was a Christian so...”
- “It doesn’t matter what you believe, just be sincere.”
- “I’ll give up all my bad habits.”
- “I’ll work real hard and earn it.”
- “I’ll be religious and go to church.”

III. WHAT’S THE SOLUTION?

Jesus Christ said, *“I AM THE WAY, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father, except THROUGH ME.”* John 14:6 (NKJV; emphasis added)

God Himself came to earth as a human being to bring us back to Himself. If any other way would have worked, Jesus Christ would not have had to come. The Way is a Person!

JESUS HAS ALREADY TAKEN CARE OF YOUR SIN PROBLEM!

“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 6:23 (NLT)

God did this for us because He loves us and wants us to know Him.

“But God shows and clearly proves His [own] love for us by the fact that while we were still sinners, Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One) died for us.” Romans 5:8 (AMP)

“For there is only one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus.” 1 Timothy 2:5 (NLT)

God has already done His part to restore our relationship to Him. He took the initiative. Now He waits for each of us to individually accept what He has done for us.

IV. WHAT DOES GOD WANT ME TO DO?

1. _____ THAT GOD HAS NOT BEEN FIRST PLACE IN YOUR LIFE AND ASK HIM TO FORGIVE YOUR SINS.

*“If we **confess** our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from every wrong.” 1 John 1:9 (NLT)*

2. _____ THAT JESUS DIED TO PAY FOR YOUR SINS AND THAT HE ROSE AGAIN ON THE THIRD DAY, AND IS ALIVE TODAY.

*“If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and **believe in your heart** that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.” Romans 10:9 (NLT)*

“Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:12 (NIV)

3. _____ GOD’S FREE GIFT OF SALVATION. DON’T TRY TO EARN IT.

*“For it is by grace you are saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the **gift of God** — not by works, so that no one can boast.” Ephesians 2:8,9 (NIV; emphasis added)*

Our relationship to God is not restored by anything we do, but on the basis of what Jesus already did for us!

4. _____ JESUS CHRIST TO COME INTO YOUR LIFE AND BE THE DIRECTOR (“LORD”) OF YOUR LIFE.

*“But to all who **believed** him and **accepted** him, he gave the right to become children of God. They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, but a birth that comes from God.” John 1:12-13 (NLT; emphasis added)*

“Listen! I am standing and knocking at your door. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in...” Revelation 3:20 (CEV)

YOU CAN TAKE THESE STEPS BY PRAYING A SIMPLE PRAYER OF COMMITMENT TO GOD:

“Dear Jesus, thank you for making me and loving me, even when I’ve ignored you and gone my own way. I realize I need you in my life and I’m sorry for my sins. I ask you to forgive me. Thank you for dying on the cross for me. Please help me to understand it more. As much as I know how, I want to follow you from now on. Please come into my life and make me a new person inside. I accept your gift of salvation. Please help me to grow now as a Christian.”

***“Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord will be saved.”** Romans 10:13 (NKJV)*

THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING BAPTIZED

I. WHY SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

1. TO FOLLOW THE EXAMPLE SET BY _____.

“At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.” Mark 1:9 (NIV)

2. BECAUSE CHRIST _____ IT.

*“(Jesus said) Therefore go and **make disciples** of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and **teaching them** to obey everything I have commanded you.”* Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV; emphasis added)

3. IT DEMONSTRATES THAT I REALLY AM A _____.

*“...many...who heard him **believed** and were **baptized**.”* Acts 18:8 (NIV; emphasis added)

*“We know that we have come to know Him if we **obey** His commands.”* 1 John 2:3 (NIV; emphasis added)

II. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF BAPTISM?

1. IT ILLUSTRATES CHRIST’S _____ AND RESURRECTION

“Christ died for our sins... He was buried...and He rose again.” 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 (NKJV)

*“For when you are **baptized**, you were **buried** with Christ, and in baptism you were also **raised** with Christ...”* Colossians 2:12 (GN; emphasis added)

2. IT ILLUSTRATES MY _____ AS A CHRISTIAN.

“...those who become Christians become new persons. They are not the same anymore, for the old life is gone. A new life has begun!” 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

*“**By our baptism then**, we were **buried** with Him and shared His death, in order that, just as Christ was **raised** from death...so also **we might live a new life**.”* Romans 6:4 (GN; emphasis added)

Baptism doesn't make you a believer — it shows that **you already believe**. Baptism does not “save” you, only your faith in Christ does that. Baptism is like a wedding ring — it's the outward symbol of the commitment you made in your heart.

*“For it is by grace you have been saved, **through faith**...it is the gift of God — not by works, so that no one can boast.”* Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV; emphasis added)

III. WHY BE BAPTIZED BY IMMERSION?

BECAUSE _____ WAS BAPTIZED THAT WAY.

“As soon as Jesus was baptized, He went up out of the water.” Matthew 3:16 (NIV)

EVERY BAPTISM IN THE _____ WAS BY IMMERSION.

(Example) *“...they went down into the water, and Philip baptized him. When they came up out of the water...”* Acts 8:38-39 (NLT)

THE WORD “BAPTIZE” MEANS TO _____ WATER”.

The Greek word *baptizo* means “to immerse or dip under water”.

IT BEST SYMBOLIZES A BURIAL AND RESURRECTION!

IV. WHO SHOULD BE BAPTIZED?

EVERY PERSON WHO HAS _____ IN CHRIST.

*“Those who believed what Peter said were **baptized...**”* Acts 2:41 (NLT; emphasis added)

*“Simon himself **believed** and was **baptized...**”* Acts 8:13 (NIV; emphasis added)

*“But **when they believed** Philip as he preached the good news...and the name of Jesus Christ, **they were baptized**, both men and women.”* Acts 8:12 (NIV; emphasis added)

At World Conquerors Church, we wait until our children are old enough to **believe** and understand the true meaning of baptism before we baptize them.

Some churches practice a “*baptism of confirmation*” for children. This ceremony is intended to be a covenant between the parents and God on the behalf of the child. The parents promise to raise their child in the faith until the child is old enough to make his own personal confession of Christ. This custom began about 300 years after the Bible was completed. **This is different from the baptism talked about in the Bible**, which was only for those old enough to believe. The purpose is to publicly confess your personal commitment to Christ.

At World Conquerors Church we will educate and equip people towards baptism in everything they do.

Over 50 people have been baptized at World Conquerors Church!

V. WHEN SHOULD I BE BAPTIZED?

AS SOON AS YOU HAVE BELIEVED!

*“Those who believed...were baptized...**that day!**”* Acts 2:41 (NLT; emphasis added)

“Then Philip began with the scripture and told him the Good News about Jesus. As they traveled along the road, they came to some water, and the man said, ‘Look, here is water! Why shouldn’t I be baptized right now?’ Philip said, ‘If you believe with all your heart, you may.’ The man answered, ‘I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.’ So they went down into the water and Philip baptized him.” Acts 8:35-38

There is no reason to delay. As soon as you have decided to receive Christ into your life, you can and should be baptized. If you wait until you are “perfect”, you’ll never feel “good enough”!

CAN MY FAMILY BE BAPTIZED TOGETHER?

Yes! If each family member understands fully the meaning of baptism, and each one has personally placed his/her trust in Christ for salvation, we encourage families to be baptized at the same time. It is a wonderful expression of commitment.

Young children who are preparing to be baptized are asked to meet with the Pastor and First Lady for a pre-baptism conversation.

However, it is important to remember that baptism is a *personal* statement of faith, not a family tradition. It is usually not wise to delay your baptism while waiting on other family members to accept Christ, particularly children. This puts an undue pressure on them, and delays *your* obedience.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR WHEN I AM BAPTIZED?

Men & women may wear a swimsuit. We provide outer clothing, towels, & changing rooms.

WILL I HAVE TO SAY ANYTHING?

At the beginning of the service, Pastor Daren will briefly explain the meaning of baptism. You will wait on the beach for your turn to be baptized. Pastor Daren, assisted by other designated ministers, will assemble the participants, lead you to the water, briefly lower you just under the water, and then you can leave the water, dry off, and watch the others. Later you will be presented with a certificate of your baptism at Sunday service or it will be mailed to you. We encourage you to invite all your relatives and friends to attend your baptism.

THE MEANING OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Jesus never asked His disciples to remember His birth. But He did instruct them to remember His death and resurrection. He gave the church two visible symbols (called "ordinances") as reminders of His death. These two ordinances are: Baptism and The Lord's Supper. The Lord's Supper is an object lesson that represents a great spiritual truth for believers.

I. WHAT IS THE LORD'S SUPPER? (1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-26 NLT)

1. IT IS A _____.

*"On the night when He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus **took some bread**..." (vs. 23; emphasis added)*

2. IT IS A _____.

"...and gave thanks to God for it. Then He broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." (vs. 24)

3. IT IS A _____.

*"In the same way, He took the cup of wine after supper, saying, **This cup** is the new covenant between God and His people – an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this to remember me as often as you drink it." (vs. 25; emphasis added)*

4. IT IS A _____.

*"For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, **you are announcing the Lord's death** until He comes again." (vs. 26; emphasis added)*

II. WHO SHOULD TAKE THE LORD'S SUPPER?

Only those who are already _____ . (Mark 14:22-26)

"For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment upon himself." 1 Corinthians 11:29 (NIV; emphasis added)

III. HOW DO I PREPARE MYSELF FOR THE LORD'S SUPPER?

"Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup." 1 Corinthians 11:27-28 (NIV)

IV. WHEN AND HOW OFTEN SHOULD WE OBSERVE THE LORD'S SUPPER?

Jesus never said when or how often believers should observe The Lord's Supper. He instituted it on a Thursday night.

PRAYER OF COMMITMENT

We'll say this prayer at the end of each session, to affirm our commitment to maturing in our relationship with God.

"Father, I realize that I was created to have fellowship with you. Thank you for making this privilege possible through Jesus' death. I know that daily fellowship with You is to be the most important thing in my life. I now want to commit myself to spending at least some time every day with you in a quiet time of Bible reading and prayer. I'm trusting in your strength to help me be consistent. In Jesus' name, Amen."

OUR LIFESTYLE STATEMENT

What We Practice

Beliefs are not worth much unless they are translated into actions. Based on what the Bible teaches, we feel very strongly about the following seven practices:

BIBLE AS OUR SOLE AUTHORITY

“The whole Bible was given to us by inspiration from God and is useful to teach us what is true and make us realize what is wrong in our lives; it straightens us out and helps us to do what is right.” 2 Timothy 3:15

Since God’s Word is the only completely reliable and truthful authority, we accept the Bible as our manual for living. Our first question when faced with a decision is “What does the Bible say?” We practice daily Bible reading, Bible study, and Bible memorization. The Bible is the basis for all we believe, so we must spend time with God’s Word daily.

AUTONOMY OF EACH LOCAL CHURCH

“He [Christ] is the head of His Body, the church; He is the source of the Body’s life...” Colossians 1:18 (GN)

Christ is the recognized head of our church - not any person, group, or religious organization. While recognizing the value of associating and cooperating with other groups of Christians, we believe every local church should be self-governing and independent from any denominational control.

PRIESTHOOD OF EVERY BELIEVER

“He [Christ] loves us, and by His sacrificial death He has freed us from our sins and made us a kingdom of priests to serve his God and Father...” Rev. 1:5-6 (GN; emphasis added) ***“...you are...the King’s priests...God’s own people, chosen to proclaim the wonderful acts of God...”*** 1 Peter 2:9 (GN; emphasis added)

The Bible teaches that every Christian is called to “full time” Christian service, regardless of his or her vocation. We practice the truth that every believer is a minister by

encouraging every member to find a place of service and ministry. Every believer has direct access to God through prayerful Bible reading.

TITHING

“A tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the Lord; it is holy to the Lord.” Leviticus 27:30 (NIV)

At World Conquerors Church we practice tithing for the support of Christ's body, the church, as God commands. We recognize that giving 10% of our income is the Biblical standard of giving.

IMMERSION

“For when you were baptized, you were buried with Christ, and in baptism you were also raised with Christ...” Colossians 2:12 (GN)

We practice baptism by immersion under water — the way Jesus was baptized, and the way the Bible commands.

SPIRIT-LED LIVING

(Jesus said) **“Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.”** John 15:5 (NLT)

We believe the only way possible to live the Christian life is by God's power within us. So we seek to practice a daily dependence on God's Spirit to enable us to do what is right. (Philippians 2:13, Ephesians 5:18) As we minister to others, we seek Holy Spirit's leading on what to say and do. As we read the Word of God, we seek God's insight in how to apply that Word to our own lives. In all that we do, we don't just rely on our own understanding, but trust God's broader perspective (Proverbs 3:5).

TELLING OTHERS ABOUT CHRIST

“Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have.” 1 Peter 3:15 (NIV)

It is the responsibility of every Christian to share the Good News with those with whom God brings us into contact. We practice personal sharing about Christ and inviting friends to church.

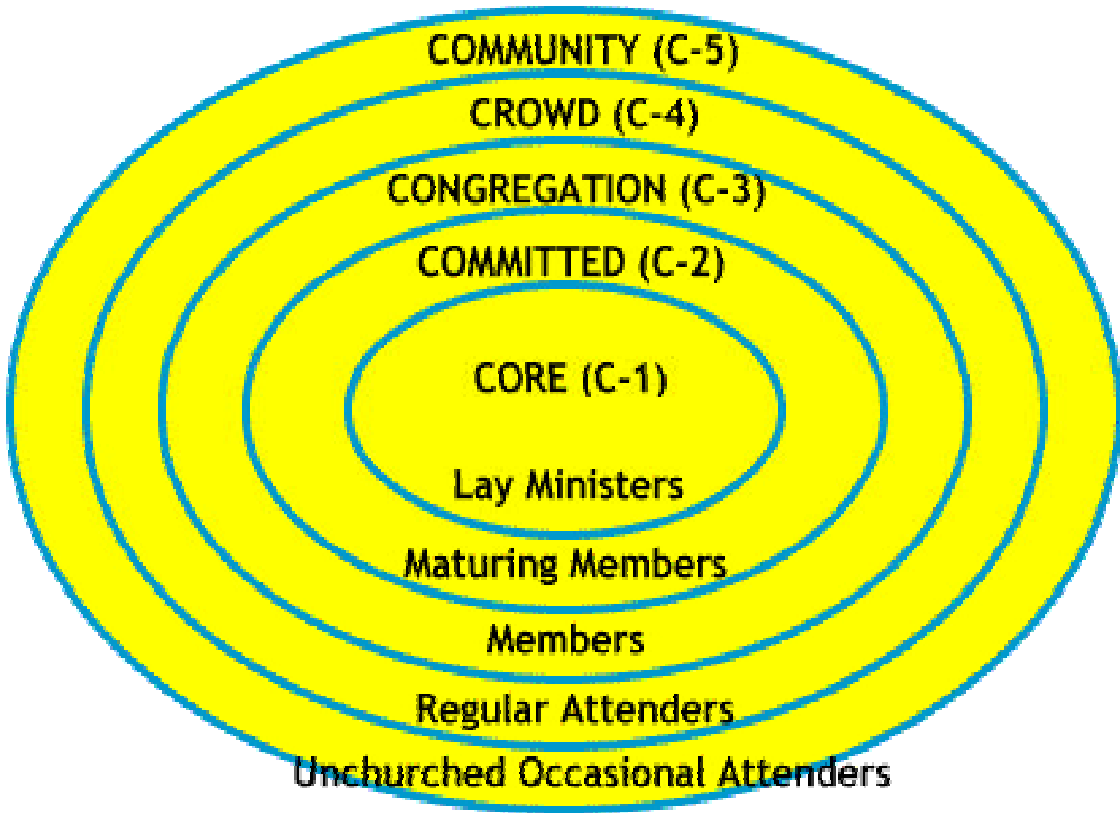

III. A PRACTICAL REASON: IT DEFINES WHO CAN BE COUNTED ON

Every team must have a roster. Every school must have an enrollment. Every business has a payroll. Every army has an enlistment. Even our country takes a census and requires voter registration. Membership identifies our family.

IV. A PERSONAL REASON: IT PRODUCES SPIRITUAL GROWTH

The New Testament places a major emphasis on the need for Christians to be accountable to each other for spiritual growth. You cannot be accountable when you’re not committed to any specific church family.

WHAT IS EXPECTED OF ME AS A MEMBER?

At World Conquerors Church we never ask our members to do more than the Bible clearly teaches. We only expect our members to do what the Bible expects every Christian to do. These responsibilities are spelled out in the Membership Covenant.
