I Receive!

Timothy 1:7 Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity or cowardice or fear, but [**He has given us a spirit**] of power and **of love** and of sound judgment and personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

After I receive God’s Love I must then renew my thinking so my past core beliefs don’t cause me to forfeit the Love God has given to me.

Proverbs 3:5 New Living Translation (NLT)

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding.

2 Corinthians 5:7 Amplified Bible (AMP)

7 for we walk by faith, not by sight [living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God’s promises]—

After I receive The Love of God then I will Renew my thinking to keep God’s Love in my heart (spirit, behavior, consciousness)

Romans 12:1-2 New Living Translation (NLT)

1 And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is

truly the way to worship him. 2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but **let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think.** Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Sometimes when we see faith in action we disregard it because it does not line up with what makes sense to us. This is sad because we miss so many God moments.

Ephesians 4:23 Living Bible (TLB)

23 Now your **attitudes** and **thoughts** must all be **constantly changing for the better.**

Ephesians 4:23 New Living Translation (NLT)

23 Instead, **let the Spirit renew your thoughts** and attitudes.

Ephesians 4:23 Amplified Bible (AMP)

23 and **be continually renewed in the spirit of your mind** [having a fresh, untarnished mental and spiritual attitude],

Love requires EVERYTHING!

Ephesians 4:20-24 The Message (MSG)

20-24 But that's no life for you. You learned Christ! My assumption is that you have paid careful attention to him, been well instructed in the truth precisely as we have it in Jesus. Since, then, we do not have the excuse of ignorance, everything—and I do mean everything—connected with that old way of life has to go. It's rotten through and through. Get rid of it! And then **take on an entirely new way of life—a God-fashioned life, a life renewed from the inside and working itself into your conduct as God accurately reproduces his character in you.**

The Love of God "Renew!"

- **We need to learn to think like we are loved so we can act like we are Loved.**
- **When we know we are Loved our decision-making is based on the Love we know instead of doubt, worry and shame.**
- **You know you have received the Love of God when you are compelled to serve and give The Love to others.**

Exodus 14:26-31 New Living Translation (NLT)

26 When all the Israelites had reached the other side, the Lord said to Moses, "Raise your hand over the sea again. Then the waters will rush back and cover the Egyptians and their chariots and

charioteers.” 27 So as the sun began to rise, Moses raised his hand over the sea, and the water rushed back into its usual place. The Egyptians tried to escape, but the Lord swept them into the sea. 28 Then the waters returned and covered all the chariots and charioteers—the entire army of Pharaoh. Of all the Egyptians who had chased the Israelites into the sea, not a single one survived. **29 But the people of Israel had walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground, as the water stood up like a wall on both sides. 30 That is how the Lord rescued Israel from the hand of the Egyptians that day. And the Israelites saw the bodies of the Egyptians washed up on the seashore. 31 When the people of Israel saw the mighty power that the Lord had unleashed against the Egyptians, they were filled with awe before him. They put their faith in the Lord and in his servant Moses.**
