The Spirit of Increase

- **We have gotten clear instructions on how to receive in the Spirit, yet we ignore it; leaving us in a position of wanting when we already have.**

Matthew 6:33 (New Living Translation, NLT)

33 Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

- **The natural habitat of The Spirit of Increase is in the Kingdom.**
- **Many of us attempt to Sow but we have a challenging time Harvesting which erodes our faith thus giving up on a Spiritual life and returning back to what we know in the natural.**
- **When you receive Jesus as your Savior and asked for His Spirit (Holy) to live in you, access was given into spiritual environments called The Kingdom of God.**
- **The benefits of the Kingdom are available to all but accessed by few; it takes faith!**

Matthew 7:13-14 (NLT)

13 "You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way. 14 But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.

Matthew 13:18-23 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

18 “Listen then to the [meaning of the] parable of the sower: 19 When anyone hears the word of the kingdom [regarding salvation] and does not understand and grasp it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is the one on whom seed was sown beside the road. 20 The one on whom seed was sown on rocky ground, this is the one who hears the word and at once welcomes it with joy; 21 yet he has no [substantial] root in himself, but is only temporary, and when pressure or persecution comes because of the word, immediately he stumbles and falls away [abandoning the One who is the source of salvation]. 22 And the one on whom seed was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, but the worries and distractions of the world and the deceitfulness [the superficial pleasures and delight] of riches choke the word, and it yields no fruit. 23 And the one on whom seed was sown on the good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands and grasps it; he indeed bears fruit and yields, some a hundred times [as much as was sown], some sixty [times as much], and some thirty.”

What happened to my Harvest?

- **Lacks understanding about the Word of the Kingdom when heard**
- **Welcomes the Word with joy, not rooted in what God’s Word says, not consistent, succumbs to pressure and persecution because of the Word, immediately falls away, abandons The Source.**
- **Hears the Word; worries, distractions, deceitfulness of the world (superficial desires of increase) kills what is heard. Yield no fruit!**

Romans 10:17 (New King James Version, NKJV)

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Genesis 8:22 (NKJV)

“While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease.”

Hebrews 11:6 (AMP)

But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him.

- **The result of your harvest is based on the content of your heart**
- **Your harvest is locked or released in your hurts habits and/or hang-ups**
- **Be careful not to let an immediate solution from the world kill your future harvest in the Spirit!**

Galatians 6:7-9 (New International Version, NIV)

7 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. **A man reaps what he sows.** 8 Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the

Spirit will reap eternal life. 9 Let us not become weary in doing good, for **at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.**
