### **Kingdom Clarity**

#### ➤ **You should know this secret!**

##### **Matthew 13:10-13 (New Living Translation, NLT)**

10 His disciples came and asked him, "Why do you use parables when you talk to the people?" 11 He replied, "You are permitted to understand the secrets (Mysteries) of the Kingdom of Heaven, but others are not. 12 To those who listen to my teaching, more understanding will be given, and they will have an abundance of knowledge. But for those who are not listening, even what little understanding they have will be taken away from them. 13 That is why I use these parables, For they look, but they don't really see. They hear, but they don't really listen or understand.

#### ➤ **The secret can only be revealed by faith.**

##### **Hebrews 11:1-3 (The Message, MSG)**

1-2 The fundamental fact of existence is that this trust in God, this faith, is the firm foundation under everything that makes life worth living. It's our handle on what we can't see. The act of faith is what distinguished our ancestors, set them above the crowd. 3 By faith, we see the world called into existence by God's word, what we see created by what we don't see.

##### **Matthew 16:19 (MSG)**

"And that's not all. You will have complete and free access to God's kingdom, keys to open any and every door: no more barriers between heaven and earth, earth and heaven. A yes on earth is yes in heaven. A no on earth is no in heaven."

- **For Clarity, we that are God’s children have a task to colonize our environments. This task is near impossible without proper training (proper training involves studying, meditating, and praying God’s Word) especially due to the fact that we have lived most of our lives living by our senses rather than by our faith. It is only by faith and His Spirit where we are able to consistently hear the Spirit of God give us directions to properly colonize and build His Kingdom on earth.**

**Matthew 6:10 (New King James Version, NKJV)**

Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.

### **Kingdom Challenge**

- ***Most of us were trained to live by our senses (smell, see, hear, touch, taste) causing most of us to judge the Word of God according to our sensual experience and environment. Which means when God commands for us to walk (live) by faith and not by senses we find ourselves questioning or not believing at all instead of obeying, causing us to get little or no benefit of being children of the King. We must understand that the Word of God (Bible) is the instruction manual for all humans, and to not follow the instructions could mean the malfunction (dysfunction) of our lives.***
- **Our Greatest Challenge is to:**
  - **Receive Holy Spirit as our guide**
  - **Recognize, then Repent for what we have done**
  - **Renew how we think**
  - **Release our old ways (life) for new ways**

**Mark 10:17-27 (MSG)**

17 As he went out into the street, a man came running up, greeted him with great reverence, and asked, “Good Teacher, what must I do to get eternal life?” 18-19 Jesus said, “Why are you calling me good? No one is good, only God. You know the commandments: Don’t murder, don’t commit adultery, don’t steal, don’t lie, don’t cheat, honor your father and mother.”

20 He said, “Teacher, I have—from my youth—kept them all!” 21 Jesus looked him hard in the eye—and loved him! He said, “There’s one thing left: Go sell whatever you own and give it to the poor. All your wealth will then be heavenly wealth. And come follow me.” 22 The man’s face clouded over. This was the last thing he expected to hear, and he walked off with a heavy heart. He was holding on tight to a lot of things, and not

about to let go. 23-25 Looking at his disciples, Jesus said, “Do you have any idea how difficult it is for people who ‘have it all’ to enter God’s kingdom?” The disciples couldn’t believe what they were hearing, but Jesus kept on: “You can’t imagine how difficult. I’d say it’s easier for a camel to go through a needle’s eye than for the rich to get into God’s kingdom.” 26 That set the disciples back on their heels. “Then who has any chance at all?” they asked. 27 Jesus was blunt: “No chance at all if you think you can pull it off by yourself. Every chance in the world if you let God do it.”

## **Kingdom Conforming**

➤ **Conform to the Word of God and not the World by renewing your mind.**

- **Romans 12:1-2**
- **Conforming: I am thankful because if I choose, I can relax by simply conforming to what God’s Word says through faith and by the leading of Holy Spirit. I am thankful because anytime I choose I can begin sowing for maximum benefits in the Kingdom by changing my worldly agendas to Kingdom agendas. I am thankful because God will insert people in my life to imitate until I can master Kingdom Living!**

**James 1:22 (Amplified, AMP)**

**But be doers of the Word [obey the message],** and not merely listeners to it, betraying yourselves [into deception by reasoning contrary to the Truth].

## **Kingdom Communication**

➤ **God wants to communicate with me!**

**Revelation 3:20-21 (MSG)**

20-21 “Look at me. I stand at the door. I knock. If you hear me call and open the door, I’ll come right in and sit down to supper with you. Conquerors will sit alongside me at the head table, just as I, having conquered, took the place of honor at the side of my Father. That’s my gift to the conquerors!

## **Kingdom Consistency**

**Proverbs 24:10 (Contemporary English Version, CEV)**

Don’t give up and be helpless in times of trouble.

**Luke 18:1 (AMP)**

Also [Jesus] told them a parable to the effect that they ought always to pray and not to turn coward (faint, lose heart, and give up).

**Proverbs 24:10 (MSG)**

If you fall to pieces in a crisis, there wasn't much to you in the first place.

**Galatians 6:9 (NLT)**

So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

**Isaiah 40:31 (AMP)**

But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired.

**Kingdom Confession**

- **Your faith in the blood of Jesus has placed you in right-standing with God. Nothing you could ever do will make you more or less righteous in His sight; you have already been made righteous! As a result, you have every right to experience God's best in your life as you pursue obedience to The instructions.**

**Mark 11:22-24 (AMP)**

22 And Jesus, replying, said to them, Have faith in God [constantly]. 23 Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him. 24 For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it].

- **Confession: In the name of Jesus, I declare that I am the righteousness of God. I have been released from the bondage of sin and I am free to exercise my rights as a born-again believer. I have a right to prosper in every area of life. The Word of God is my guarantee that I can speak as God speaks and call into existence everything that I need to succeed. I take authority over sickness, disease, poverty and insufficiency, and I rule as a king in life!**
- **Find the words you need. (Matthew 7:7)**
- **Fill your heart with those words. (Matthew 12:34)**
- **Fix your mind on those new words. (Isaiah 26:3)**
- **Walk by Faith with God's Word. (2 Corinthians 5:7)**
- **Enjoy a Fulfilling life. (Psalm 34:8)**

## **Kingdom Consecration**

- **Defining Consecration: The Bible says, "You shall consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy, for I am the Lord your God" (Leviticus 20:7).**
- **A technical definition of consecration means that you are to set yourself apart from unrighteousness, turn to the Lord, and be prepared to be used by God.**
  
- **Benefits of Consecration**
  - 1. So I can realize my purpose as I am being used by God.**
  - 2. So I can finally experience God's peace taking care of me as I obey His commands (Matthew 6:33, Philippians 4:6-7).**
  - 3. So I can do what I want to do by creating discipline of doing things I don't want to do.**

### **Proverbs 4:23-27 (NLT)**

23 Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life. 24 Avoid all perverse talk; stay away from corrupt speech. 25 Look straight ahead, and fix your eyes on what lies before you. 26 Mark out a straight path for your feet; stay on the safe path. 27 Don't get sidetracked; keep your feet from following evil.

- **Why should I enter into consecration?**
  - **Opportunity to cleanse my external environment which battles with my internal environment where Christ lives.**
  - **Opportunity to allow the Word of God to train me to live from the inside out.**
  - **Opportunity to understand that Christ lives in me so I can change and colonize environments and not allow environments to change me.**
  
- **Kingdom Consecration**
  - **Separate ➤ Stimulate ➤ Saturate ➤ Dedicate**
