### **Restoration is a process**

- **Joseph – Went from slavery to the palace to jail to be second in command**
- **David – Went from being a shepherd boy to a war hero to hiding for his life to a king...**
- **Daniel – Was selected to be one of the kings men. Passed the test, had dreams and was raised up, had friends thrown in the fiery furnace and was delivered. He prayed and ended up in the Lions Den the raised up again**
- **John – was called the disciple whom Jesus loved. Ran away when Jesus was arrested. Restored after Jesus resurrection, preached and was exiled to the Isle Patmos and wrote the book of Revelation**

### **Watch out! You will continue to go through**

#### **John 16:33 (New Living Translation, NLT)**

I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world.”

#### **Luke 4:13 (Amplified, AMP)**

And when the devil had ended every [the complete cycle of] temptation, he [temporarily] left Him [that is, stood off from Him] until another more opportune *and* favorable time.

## **Are you backsliding or are you growing?**

### **Mark 4:14-20 (The Message, MSG)**

“The farmer plants the Word. Some people are like the seed that falls on the hardened soil of the road. No sooner do they hear the Word than Satan snatches away what has been planted in them. “And some are like the seed that lands in the gravel. When they first hear the Word, they respond with great enthusiasm. But there is such shallow soil of character that when the emotions wear off and some difficulty arrives, there is nothing to show for it. “The seed cast in the weeds represents the ones who hear the kingdom news but are overwhelmed with worries about all the things they have to do and all the things they want to get. The stress strangles what they heard, and nothing comes of it. “But the seed planted in the good earth represents those who hear the Word, embrace it, and produce a harvest beyond their wildest dreams.”

### **Hebrews 2:1 (NLT)**

So we must listen very carefully to the truth we have heard, or we may drift away from it.

## **It's not automatic**

### **John 15:1-11 (NLT)**

1 “I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener. 2 He cuts off every branch of mine that doesn't produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more. 3 You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. 4 Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful unless you remain in me. 5 “Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. 6 Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned. 7 But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! 8 When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father. 9 “I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. 10 When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love. 11 I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!

## **Get the jumper cables**

### **➤ Be filled with the Holy Spirit – Again!**

### **Ephesians 5:18 (AMP)**

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery; but ever be filled and stimulated with the [Holy] Spirit.

➤ **Stir up the gift**

**2 Timothy 1:6 (New King James Version, NKJV)**

Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

➤ **Remain steady**

**1 Corinthians 15:58 (King James Version, KJV)**

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, for as much as ye know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.
